### **Water and Wastewater**

- Well #5 is in full operation. (Project Complete)
- Walmart lift station is replaced and running well. (Project Complete)
- Water line replacement project is complete.
- Still working to finish swapping out all the meters.
- Waiting for an engineering estimate to replace the Mayo lift station

### **Electric Department**

- Working on a plan for Christmas lights next year.
- Finley is working on the long-range plan

- Pole changeout waiting on material
- Had an unground line on Crestwood go bad during boring. Working to have it replaced.
