

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 40-23 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ASSIGNING STREET NAMES TO STREETS LOCATED WITHIN THE CITY PARK.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Lamar, Missouri, as follows:

Section 1. Section 40-23 of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended and shall hereafter read as follows:

Sec. 40-23. Street names.

(a) The streets of the city shall be known and designated as follows:

(1) The street running north and south on the west side of the public square is hereby named Gulf Street and the streets proceeding west from Gulf Street are hereby named Cherry Street, Walnut Street, Maple Street and Oak Street.

(2) The street running north and south on the east side of the public square is hereby named Broadway and the streets running north and south proceeding east from Broadway are hereby named Poplar Street, Mill Street, Grand Avenue, Truman Avenue, Parry Street, Lexington Avenue, Jackson Avenue, Jefferson Avenue, Hagny Street, Allen Street and Howard Street.

(3) The streets running east and west, north of First Street in an unplatted tract commonly known as Mayo Addition shall be named as follows:

- a. The first street north of First Street shall be named Arbor Drive.
- b. The second street north of First Street shall be named Bluebell Drive.
- c. The third street north of First Street shall be named Camellia Drive.
- d. The fourth street north of First Street shall be named Dogwood Drive.

(4) The streets in Mayo Addition running north and south shall correspond to the nearest street running north and south, south of First Street, except that the last street to the east is hereby named Bartlett Drive, and except that the last street to the west is hereby named Mayo Street.

(5) The street lying along the half section line of Section 24, Township 32, Range 31 and the half section line of Section 19, Township 32, Range 30 is hereby named First Street and streets, except as hereinafter noted, running east and west proceeding south shall be numbered

numerically, Second Street, Third Street and so on.

(6) The street running west from Broadway to Maple Street and immediately south of First Street is hereby named First Terrace.

(7) The first street east of Jackson Avenue in College Hill Addition, running north and south is hereby named College Street, the second, Heagon Street and the third, Francis Street.

(8) The streets in Lakeview Addition running east and west shall be named to correspond with the presently existing streets in the city commencing at the north and the first street to the north shall be named 16th Street, the next street 17th Street, the next 18th Street, the next 18th Terrace and the last 19th Street. The street running north and south, north from 19th Street to 16th Street and immediately east of Hagny is hereby named Lakeview Drive.

(9) The one existing street in Northridge Acres Addition is hereby named Northridge Drive.

(10) The streets running east and west from Truman Street and immediately north of Third Street are hereby named Second Terrace.

(11) The street running east from Poplar Street to Truman Street and immediately south of Third Street is hereby named Third Terrace.

(12) The street running east from Jefferson Street to a dead end and immediately south of Sixth Street is hereby named Sixth Terrace.

(13) The street running east from Howard Street to Wheeler Drive and immediately north of Eighth Street is hereby named Memorial Drive.

(14) The street running east from College Street to Heagon Street and immediately south of 16th Street is hereby named 16th Terrace.

(15) The street intersecting W 10th Lane, otherwise known as Central Road at such intersection, located 0.50 miles north of Highway 160, running thence east from said intersection 0.50 miles, thence south 0.35 miles, thence east approximately 0.37 miles to the intersection with SW 1st Lane, is hereby named Harvest Road.

(16) Within the City Park:
a. the street that commences at its northern intersection with Walnut Street and initially running westerly, then counter-clockwise around the Lamar Aquatic Park proceeding

easterly to Cherry St, is hereby named Park Avenue;

b. the circular one-way street running counter-clockwise in the northeastern area of the park is hereby named Sacred Circle; and

c. the street that encircles the tennis court, basketball courts, field 1 and field 2, is hereby named Tiger Way.

(b) In the establishment of any new additions, streets therein shall be named, if possible, to correspond with any existing street with which it connects or with which it corresponds.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

Section 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
